Public Transit	Invest \$9 billion in Toronto transit including building the Relief Line, Yonge North Subway Extension and the Waterfront LRT	Fund 50% of TTC's operating costs (330 million) and build Relief Line	Ford wants more subways built but does not commit to funding	Provide permanent operational funding support for municipal transit services
Cycling	Invest \$25.6 million in Toronto Cycling infrastructure	Update Ontario's Cycling Strategy and pass a Vulnerable Road Users' Law	Ford has voted against bike lanes and infrastructure as councillor	Invest in cycling infrastructure
Organic Waste	Implemented a Food and Organic Waste Framework which includes developing and implementing organic waste disposal ban	Supports waste diversion methods	Unknown	Turn organic waste into compost and renewable natural gas by requiring organic source separation and banning organic waste from disposal
